ASSE SERIES 7000

The ASSE 7000-2008 is the Professional Certification Standard for Plumbing-Based Residential Fire Protection Systems. It covers the minimum requirements for an individual to become an Installer and/or inspector of these systems. The Series 7000 was developed under the American National Standards Institute (ANSI) policy of openness and consensus. It was ANSI approved in June 2009.

The ASSE Certification provides assurance to the industry that only qualified individuals are installing and inspecting multi-purpose piping systems. The ASSE Certification also assures that individuals have taken a qualified course and have passed both a written and a practical exam. The program provides for continued education and periodic recertification.

ASSE CERTIFICATION PROGRAM

- Nationally recognized third party certification agency.
- Maintains all certification records.
- Notifies schools and individuals when it is time to recertify.
- Reports directly to local jurisdictions.
