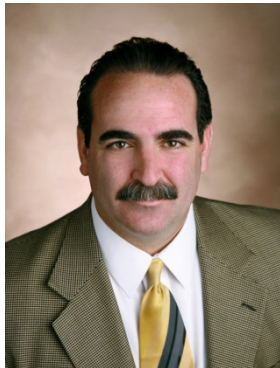


Steven Scandaliato, SET, CFPS
